Cancer Research UK's International Projects Terms & Conditions

1. Entries will only be accepted on receipt of the registration fee which is your personal (non-refundable/non-transferable) contribution. Part of this sum will be used as deposit towards the costs of your project according to the tour operator's terms and conditions and the balance will be used to cover our initial administration costs. We act as agents for the tour operator and we shall issue an ATOL receipt for the part of your registration fee paid by way of deposit to the tour operator. Cheques should be payable to 'Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd'. The registration fee does not count towards your minimum fundraising target.
2. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd reserves the right to refuse an applicant entry to an event at its sole discretion.
3. In order to participate in the challenge of your choice you must raise the minimum sponsorship target as specified above. 80% must be sent direct to Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd at least ten weeks prior to departure and the balance four weeks after completion of the challenge. If you are unable to raise the minimum sponsorship, you may choose to make up the balance yourself or forfeit your place. Please note Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd cannot refund personal contributions made by participants to achieve their minimum sponsorship.
4. All funds raised in connection with our International Projects must be payable to 'Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd' in £ sterling. Please convert pledges to £ sterling.
5. Charities Aid Foundation cheques can only be accepted in respect of the balance of sponsorship money due four weeks after the completion of the challenge, and must be made payable to 'Cancer Research UK'.
6. Participants must be at least 18 years old on the departure date. Those aged over 60 or those who have answered "Yes" to any of the questions on the medical questionnaire must provide a signed and completed doctor's certificate.
7. Your passport must be valid for at least six months from date of return to the UK. You are responsible for ensuring that you have a valid passport and any appropriate visa for the project. Passport control and in-country authorities will reserve the right to refuse entry.
8. Payment of airport tax, visa costs, insurance, travel to and from airport in UK, personal kit and gratuities are not included and must be paid for by the participant.
9. Participants must be fit enough to take part in the project and must complete a medical questionnaire in order to register. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd reserves the right to refuse a participant if (s)he is deemed medically unfit to take part.
10. You must not suffer from alcohol or drug dependency or have any criminal convictions nor must illegal substances be carried or consumed by participants on an International Project.
11. All flights, flight timings, itinerary, accommodation and arrangements are subject to change without notice, should climatic or any other unforeseen circumstances deem this necessary.
12. Cancer Research UK's International Projects are organised by various tour operators. Across the Divide organise all our current International Projects. Across the Divide Ltd ATOL No 6475.

13. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd is acting as agent for the tour operator who will organise your project and you agree to abide by the tour operator's booking conditions. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd's liability to compensate you for any damage or loss (including death or personal injury) shall only arise where such damage or loss is as a result of Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd's negligence. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd shall not be liable to compensate you for any damage or loss resulting from the negligent act or omission of any other person, including the tour operator, its employees, contractors and suppliers. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd's liability (if any) for any damage or loss shall not in any event be greater than the tour operator's liability to compensate you for damage and loss as specified in the tour operator's booking conditions.
14. If you choose, for whatever reason, not to take up your place, all sponsorship forms and sponsorship monies collected must be forwarded to Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd.
15. Participants must be covered by travel insurance, this must provide adequate medical cover and repatriation insurance for travelling in a remote location and suitable third party cover. Each tour operator has arranged a suitable and competitive policy. Details will be sent nearer departure. If you obtain your own insurance, you must send a copy of the policy at least six weeks before departure and sign a declaration stating that in the event of a claim you personally guarantee to reimburse the tour operator for any expenditure incurred on your behalf.
16. If you cancel your place on the challenge for any reason, no refund is payable as your sponsorship was raised for charitable purposes. However, you may be offered an alternative project which may involve an additional payment to cover any cancellation charges incurred by Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd in accordance with the tour operator's booking conditions. If cancellation occurs in circumstances where recovery of cancellation charges is indemnified under your travel insurance, you hereby agree that you will co-operate in the recovery of these charges from the insurers, and that any sums recovered under the policy will be paid to Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd. If the project is cancelled or postponed by Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd or the tour operator for any reason, including but not limited to failure to achieve the minimum number of participants required for the project, or following the issue of any advice from the Foreign and Commonwealth Office advising against travel to any destination included in the project or if any other cause beyond the reasonable control of Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd and/or the tour operator renders the performance of this agreement impossible, you will be entitled to a refund of your registration fee unless you accept an offer to go on the postponed project (if applicable) or on an alternative project (if available).
17. Participants acknowledge that the tour operator is neither an agent nor partner of Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd and that the tour operator has sole responsibility for organising and running the project and for the health and safety of participants. However, participants have the same responsibility for their health, safety and possessions as they do at home. Participants should report any complaints about the travel, accommodation and other arrangements for the project to the tour operator. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd shall not be responsible or liable to compensate participants in respect of any matters upon which such complaints are based.
18. Cancer Research UK's International projects are promoted by Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd. Cancer Research UK Trading Ltd is a wholly owned subsidiary of Cancer Research UK registered charity number 1089464 to which it gift aids its taxable profits.
19. By taking part, all participants confirm that they are happy for any photographs taken during their participation in an International Projects to be used by Cancer Research UK to publicise International Projects and by Cancer Research UK generally.
20. This agreement shall be governed by English law and be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.
