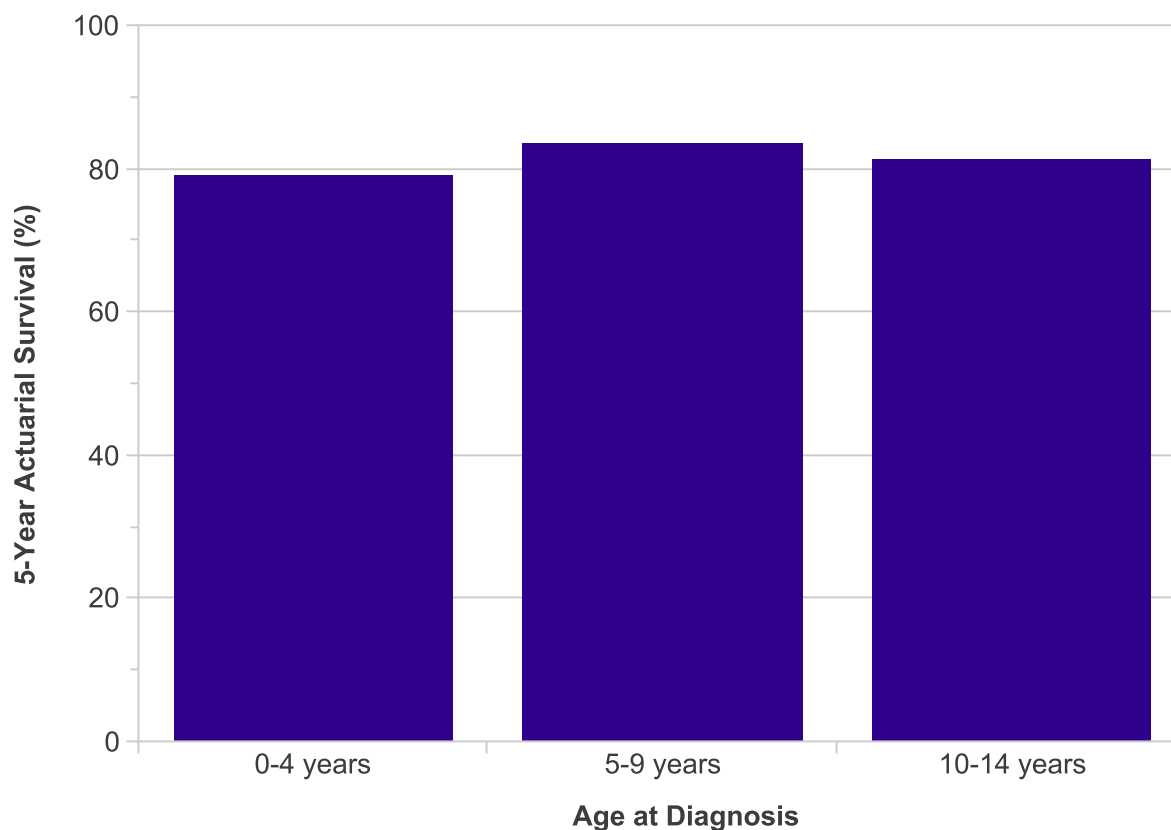


Childhood Cancer, 2006 Five-Year Actuarial Survival (%), By Age, England

0-4 years	79
5-9 years	84
10-14 years	81
